Queensland Seniors Month October 2025

Overview

The Queensland Government and Council on the Ageing (COTA) Queensland value the contributions that older people have made, and continue to make, in their communities. We share a commitment to building an age-friendly Queensland.

Queensland Seniors Month runs from 1–31 October, and includes the celebration of Grandparents Day on Sunday, 26 October 2025.

COTA Queensland coordinates Queensland Seniors Month on behalf of the Queensland Government and receives funding to collaboratively plan and subsidise events and activities.

During Queensland Seniors Month 2024, an estimated 32,500 older Queenslanders connected with their communities through a range of funded events across the state.

These events provided older Queenslanders with opportunities to celebrate and create meaningful connections with each other and the important people in their lives and to find out about the supports and services available to them.

Seniors Month 2025 theme

The theme for Queensland Seniors Month 2025 is Connect and celebrate.

Creating opportunities for older people to celebrate and create meaningful connections with each other and the important people in their lives is at the heart of this year's month.

Seniors Month 2025 recognises strong communities are connected communities. It focuses on the importance of ensuring Queensland Seniors are cared for and supported to live active, healthy and productive lives and are celebrated for their contributions—whether as volunteers, employees or business owners, community leaders or carers, grandparents or advocates.

Throughout Seniors Month older people are encouraged to connect in their communities to build friendships with people they may not otherwise meet and find out about the supports and services available to them.

Through these opportunities we can increase the feeling of social connectedness and support and empower Queensland seniors to connect, participate, contribute and thrive.
